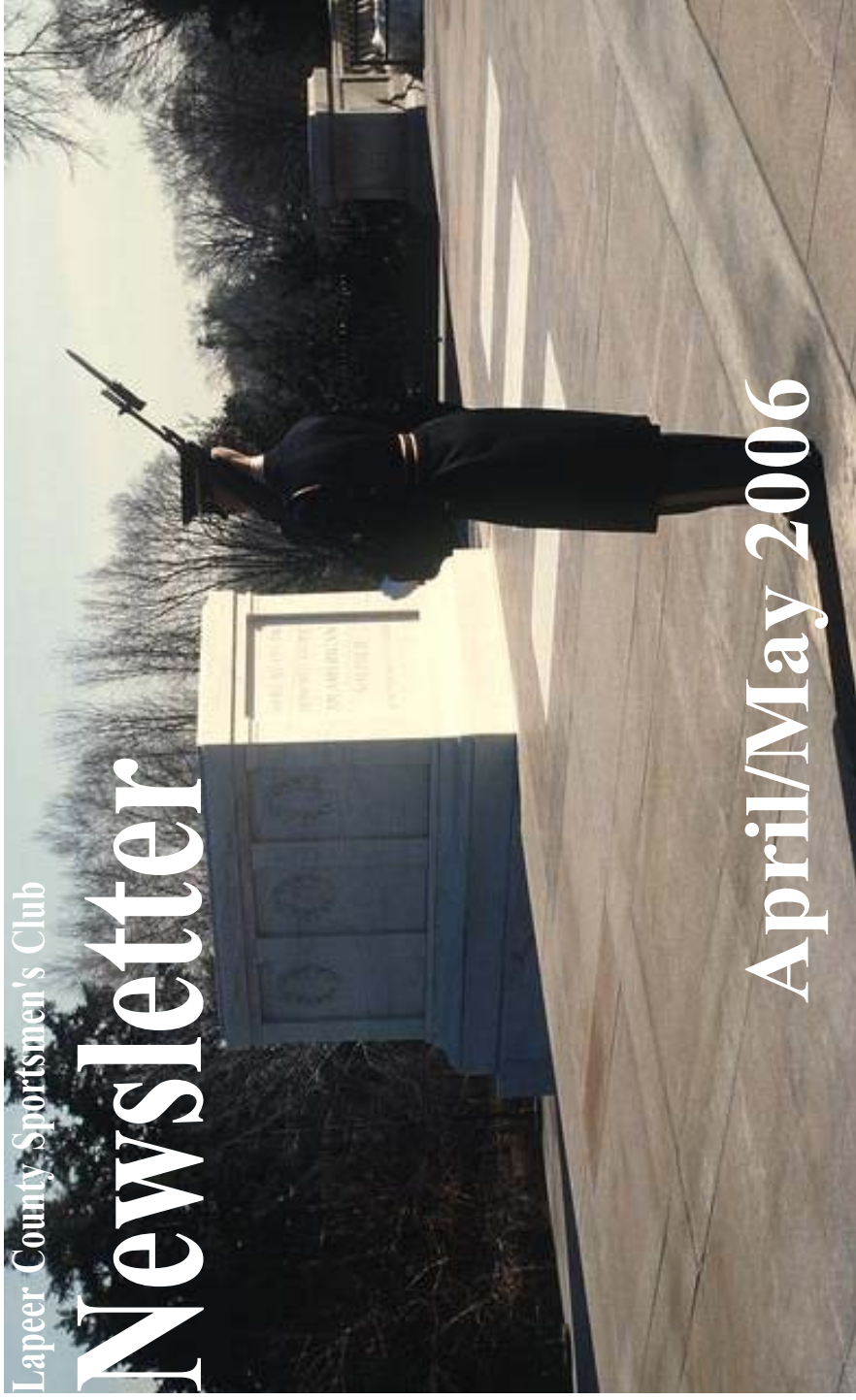

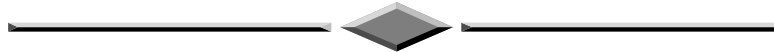

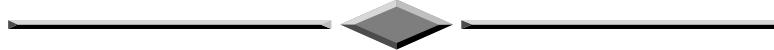

Military Rifle Is Coming Soon!

MONDAY ... MONDAY ... MONDAY!!

The first Monday in May is fast approaching with the speed of an F14 on full afterburner, and that can only mean one thing, it's time for military rifle. So, get out the old iron, oil her up, and come on out.

Whether you have an M1 Garand, SKS, AK, M14, AR, or 03, whatever, it doesn't matter. Not familiar with the operation of your rifle or rifle not sighted in? No problem, there will be people there to help.

The normal course of fire is paper targets at 15, 25, 50 and 100 yards, and steel targets at 100 and 200 yards. It takes 20 rounds to shoot the course, so bring at least 40 rounds. And, there isn't a timer. So, no hurry, no worry, no problem.

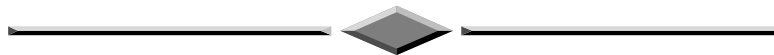
This year we are also inviting the pistol caliber carbine shooters. Similar course of fire as the rifles, just a little shorter. So, if you are a cowboy shooter or deer hunter and need practice, or fun, come on down!

Cost for members is \$3.00 and guests are \$8.00. Shooting starts at 5:00 pm and runs till dark. Remember the first Monday in May to the last Monday in September is military rifle shoot. So come on out to improve your skills, have some fun, and smell the gunpowder!!!
